

By removing seasonal ups and downs, seasonally adjusted annual rates (SAAR). from one season to the next and from one month to the next. Reporting monthly figures at annual rates indicates the annual level of starts tha maintained for 12 months. This facilitates comparison of the current pace of activity to annual forecasts as well as to historical annual levels.
