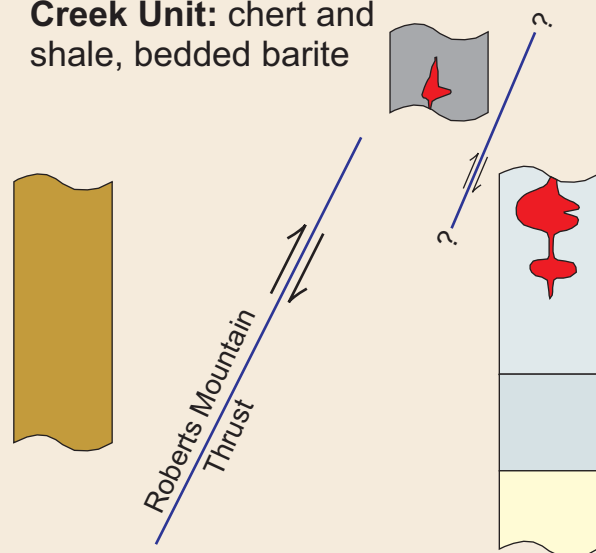


CARLIN TREND:

Late Ordovician Vinini Formation: siltstone, shale, chert, and sandstone

Devonian Rodeo Creek Unit: chert and shale, bedded barite



Ordovician to Devonian Bootstrap Limestone: massive oolitic limestone, dolomitic siltstone, argillite, silty limestone

Ordovician Hanson Creek Formation: massive dolomite

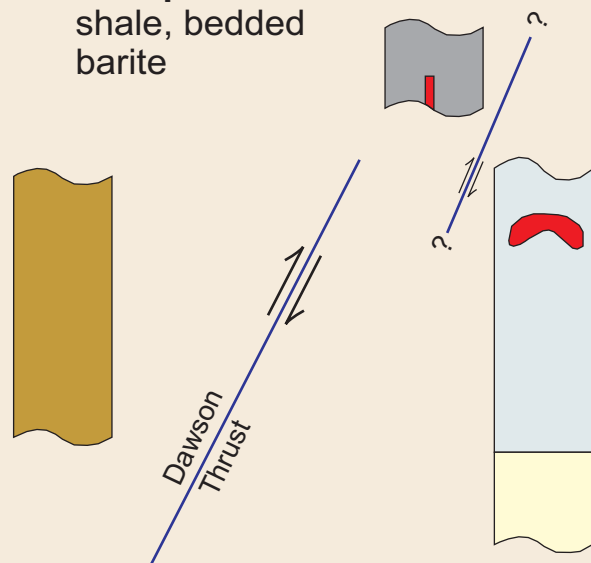
Ordovician Eureka Quartzite: vitreous clean quartzite

Upper Proterozoic Yusezyu Formation: phyllite, meta-siltstone, marble
