The governments of Canada and Quebec fund 36 projects to improve water infrastructure in the Chaudière-Appalaches region

Investment of more than \$62.3 million

Clean Water and Wastewater Fund (CWWF) and New Building Canada Fund, Small Communities Fund

The governments of Canada and Quebec are investing \$62,350,753 in 36 water and wastewater projects to ensure residents of the Chaudière-Appalaches region have access to clean and reliable water sources. Funding for the 34 projects under the Clean Water and Wastewater Fund was made possible by [the signing of the bilateral agreement on July 5, 2016](#).

The Government of Canada is contributing a total of \$37,397,685 for all of the projects while the province is providing \$24,953,068. The municipalities will provide the remaining funding.
