Political Prisoners in Burma!

According to Amnesty International and Assistance Association Political Prisoners (Burma):

- Even though 200 political prisoners were released October 12, 90 % of political prisoners remain behind bars.
- Nearly 2,000 political prisoners, including monks, students and labour activists still remain in various prisons.
- Prison conditions are deplorable; 146 prisoners have died since 1988 due to disease, malnutrition and maltreatment by prison authorities
- The release of ALL political prisoners, along with their free participation in the political process is an essential step towards acceptable political liberalization in Burma.

As a concerned Canadian, I strongly urge you to free all political prisoners in Burma.
