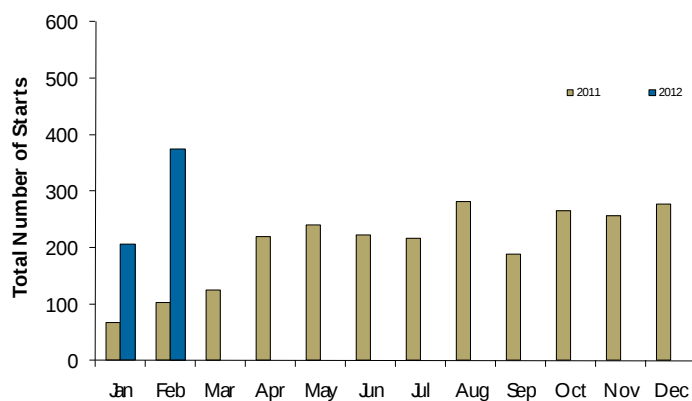


Total Starts Surged in February
