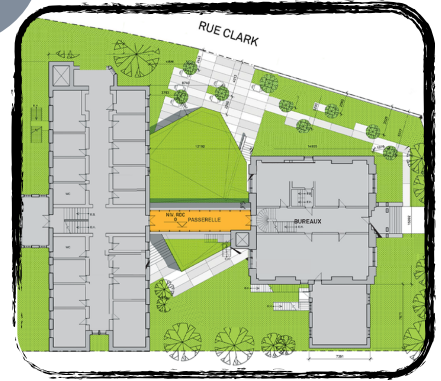

Notman House is a not-for-profit, community-led initiative motivated by the surge of grassroots events, activities and interest in Web-centric technology startups with the objective of cultivating Montreal's role in this economy of the future.

Open to all, Notman embraces the open, innovative and collaborative spirit of today's Web culture by exposing new ideas, the latest methods and entrepreneurial inspiration to students, entrepreneurs, investors, corporations as well as the general public.

Built in 1844 and classified as a historical monument in 1979, the House stands adjacent to what is known as the St. Margaret's Hospital. The two properties will soon be connected by a café, open to the public.

Over the past 18 months Notman House has become a showcase for collaboration and a landmark in Montreal's startup scene, with hundreds of community events,

thousands of visitors and dozens of startups taking advantage of events, offices, meeting rooms and cafe space.

Having proven its economic potential, Notman House became a pillar of Quebec's Strategy for Entrepreneurship in 2011 and will receive significant financial support from Municipal, Provincial and Federal governments, as well as the private sector.



The Montreal-based not for profit OSMO Foundation, established in 2009, is mandated to fund, by way of grants, grassroots initiatives that support community building and networking. OSMO's mission is to use its financial resources to facilitate the transfer of knowledge, experience and relationships between experienced entrepreneurs, their support-ecosystems and aspiring entrepreneurs.

The Foundation was created by investors, technology and media executives and the community itself to support the growth and development of Montreal's next generation of technology entrepreneurs.

The OSMO Foundation acquired Notman House and the St. Margaret's Hospital on December 19th 2012. Construction is set to begin on January 21st 2013 with completion due in Summer 2013.
