Tim Kenny

Tim Kenny is passionate about nature. He has fully embraced Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) by working tirelessly and giving generously in support of its wetland conservation mission. Tim was elected to the DUC Board of Directors in March 1991, and was named Director Emeritus in 2004 when he retired from the Board.
