

Figure 2 Showing outline of the Frenchman's Creek tenements in red, overlain on a true colour satellite image. Areas disturbed by alluvial mining show clearly as light brown areas following creeks which drain mostly southwards from the inferred gold source area shown outlined in yellow. This source area potentially indicates a regional scale gold bearing structure of which some 13 kilometres strike are contained within the tenements. The Pott falls mine is located within the inferred gold source area but the Parrot pit is not indicating the potential for other mineralised structures.
